

Book Written by a Child about Coping with the Loss of a Loved One is Released


The Birthday of an Angel Debuts on May 14 at The Shlenker School of Congregation Beth Israel

The Birthday of an Angel is an inspirational journey of an everlasting relationship. Rather than



focusing on the loss of a loved one, this book shares a different perspective. The book presents the idea that loved ones are angels, who will always be with those they love on earth. In the 24-page hardcover book, Hess shares memories of her late grandfather, Houston-based Dr. Morton J. Adels, and explains how she continues to connect with him even after his passing.

No other book, written by a child, explains the loss of a loved one from this unique and positive perspective. Both children and adults of all faiths can easily identify with this story and use the information to develop their own coping skills.

"I hope my book helps people who are struggling with the loss

of a loved one," Hess said. "I want people to *believe* that their loved ones aren't gone. I want the readers to learn how to connect in various ways with their angel and realize that their angel is always part of them."
